



Charnwood Classic Tour 2023 Supplementary Regulations

EVENT ANNOUNCEMENT

1. Coalville Car Club will organise a Touring Assembly - on **Sunday 24th September 2023**.
2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK, incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, these Supplementary Regulations & any written instructions that the organisers may issue for the event.
3. A Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption has been issued for the event – Number 132341.

ELIGIBILITY

4. The event is open to all cars; however, historics, classics, interesting or sporting modern cars would be especially welcome.
5. All cars should be presented in good condition. The organisers reserve the right to decline any car showing damage. Each car must be taxed for the road and have a valid MOT Certificate, if applicable.
6. Participating cars will be identified by a tour plate, which will be supplied by the organisers. This should be displayed in a prominent forward facing position on the front of the vehicle.

INSURANCE

7. All entrants must ensure that their cars have adequate insurance to enter the event. It is the driver's responsibility to ensure the vehicle is properly insured. A standard motor car policy may well cover use on the public highway during this event. If in doubt, please seek advice from your insurance company. As a Touring Assembly operating under a Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption public liability is covered by Motorsport UK's Public Liability Policy. However, this does not provide vehicle insurance as required under the Road Traffic Acts.

ENTRIES

8. Entries open on publication of these regulations, and close on Sunday 10th September 2023. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of **£50** for two people travelling in the car.

The entry fee includes one road book, one souvenir rally plate, two breakfast rolls & drinks at the start and two tea and cake or ice creams at the finish. Please add **£12.50** for each additional passenger to cover catering costs.

9. Entry forms and fees should be sent to the Secretary of the Meeting (see paragraph 23).

Please make cheques payable to **Coalville Car Club**.

If you would like to pay by bank transfer the account details are on the Entry Form. Please include an obvious reference e.g. driver's surname or vehicle registration number.

10. The maximum number of cars on the event is 50. The minimum is 20. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and refund entry fees in full.

11. If an entrant particularly wants to run close to another entry(s), then this should be noted in the appropriate space on the entry form, and we will do our best to accommodate you.

12. Each entry will be **acknowledged by email** unless you indicate a preference for post on the entry form. The cost of entries withdrawn in writing received prior to Sunday 10th September 2023 will be refunded in full. Thereafter refunds will be at the organisers' discretion.

13. Final Instructions will be issued not later than 5 days before the Tour, by email or post as requested.

DOCUMENTATION

14. Cars & crews should arrive at the start from 09.00 am and no later than 1 hour before their due start time which will be advised in the final instructions. Follow the signs to the dedicated parking area. You will have time to “Sign On”, get your breakfast rolls & hot drink and chat to fellow tourists.

15. A basic vehicle scrutineering check will be carried out at the start. The organisers reserve the right to exclude any vehicle which, in their opinion, is unsuitable for participation in the tour.

16. After signing on, crews will be issued with their tour plate and road book.

ROUTE

17. Start: **The George and Dragon, Ashby Road, Thringstone, Leicestershire, LE67 8UH**

A breakfast roll and hot drink is included for each crew member in the entry fee.

The first car will leave at 10.30 am. Cars will start at one minute intervals to avoid bunching.

18. Lunch Halt: **Burghley House, Stamford, PE9 4QN**

Located to the southeast of Stamford, Burghley house is a magnificent 16th century stately home and gardens with an extensive deer park remodelled by Capability Brown in the 18th century. There are picnic areas near to the house as well as the Orangery Restaurant and Garden Café. Entry to the parklands is free but there are additional charges for entry to the house and formal gardens. Approximately two hours is allocated for the lunch stop in the schedule.

19. Finish: **Ferneley’s Ice Cream, Brickfield Farm, Leesthorpe, Melton Mowbray, LE14 2XJ**

Where hot drinks with cake or two scoops of delicious Fearnley’s ice cream will be served (included in the entry fee). We should be joining their monthly car show on the field behind the cafe.

20. The route will cover approximately 110 miles on asphalt roads in Leicestershire, Rutland and the surrounding counties. The route will be given in an easy to follow “Tulip” road book which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event. Although not required to complete the route, entrants may like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey Landranger maps 129, 130, 140 & 141. The road book will also contain tourist information notes on places of interest along the route and some (optional) observation quiz questions to entertain you.

21. As ever please be mindful of other road users particularly cyclists, horse riders and walkers. There is no average speed to keep to so don’t speed, but don’t dawdle either. We want to celebrate and re-create the joys of motor touring. Respect other tourists and if a queue forms behind you, please move over and allow them to pass.

22. We will again be supporting The Royal British Legion. If you would like to donate there will be a collection box at the start and finish.
